

Crop	Stages	Problems	Agro-meteorological advisories	
	Light to Moderate Rainfall**			
General Condition	The sky will be cloudy. High relative humidity will be experienced. The atmospheric temperature will come down.			
The atmosphere may be turbid due to heavy wind				
Weather warning	There will be light to moderate rainfalls from August 20 to 23.			
Impacts	Damaging and losses or deteriorating quality of the open drying agricultural produces like copra, rubber, cashew nuts, seeds, food materials for processing etc			
	Damages and losses may occur for crops having slender stems like banana and vegetables.  Breaking branches and or trees may ocurr.  Chances for water stagnation in the fields.			
General Recommendati	Do not dry any products on open conditions.			
ons	Do not go for open field operations if heavy rain is experienced			
	Keep livestock and poultries within strong structures. Do not keep livestock under open comditions or under trees.			
	Do not keep seeds, perishable goods, fertilizers, cattle and poultry feeds on moist floothem in rooms on elevated platforms			
	Travelling may be po	estponed.		

	Closely follow the directions of disaster management authorities. Pepople living near seash and on banks of river/waterbodies may take extreme care.			
Paddy	Various stages	Borwn spot disease	Prophylactic spray of <i>Pseudomonas</i> fluorescens (@ 20g/l) is recommended.  If disease appears only, spray fungicide Nativo® (@ 4g per 10 litres of water)	
Coconut	All stages	Bud rot	Detection of disease at its early stage will help to adopt efficient corrective measures. Cut and remove the affected tissues from the crown and apply Bordeaux paste. After that cover the cut surface with polythene sheets to protect it from rain falls until new leaf emerges.  Burn the removed tissues immediately.  As a prophylactic measure spray 1% Bordeaux mixture into the axils of top leaves of the surrounding palms	
Black pepper	Newly planted/early growth stages	Quick wilt disease	Spray Redomil (@2g/litre of water) or copper oxy chloride (@3g/litre of water)  Drench the soil in the basins with the same preparation (@ 5 litre per vine) as mentioned above.	
All crops	Different stages	Giant African Snail	For trapping the snails, put wet gunny bags filled with leaves of cabbage or cauliflower or papaya in the evening around cattle sheds/houses. The snails can be destroyed by putting them in saline water (200g salts per litre of water)  The snails on the crops can be destroyed by spraying 0.3% (3g per litre of water) copper sulfate	
Banana	Various stages of growth	Rhizome rot	Ensure good drainage in the garden  Drench with Streprocyclin antibiotic (@2g/10L)  Or  Copperhydroxide (20g/10L) at the basin of the plant.	

Ginger	Early growth stage	Wilt disease	Apply lime @ 200 kg per acre of land and thoroughly mix with soil.  Use bio control agents, Trichoderma/Pseudomonas.  Pull out and destroy the affected plants immediately when the disease is noticed.  Drench the fields with 1% Bordeaux mixture
Cow	Any stage	FMD (Foot and Mouth disease)	Foot and Mouth disease is a highly transmissible disease caused by infection with an Aphthovirus. The infection results in vesicular lesions in and around the mouth and on the feet, resulting in the reluctance of an animal to eat or move. <b>Prevention:</b> Ensure hygienic conditions for the individual animals as well as their shelter and its surroundings. Boost the immunity of cattle by supplementing feeds with vitamins and minerals containing health tonics. If disease appears, give medication under the supervision of a Veterinary doctor immediately.
