

## **Agro Meteorological Advisories:**

Crop	Stage of the crop / Pest/Disease	Advisories
Paddy (Jyothi, Kanchana)	Seedling stage/Rice case worm	There is a chance of rice case worm in paddy field. To control this 25 kg sawdust or rice husk ash mixed with 1 litre kerosene can be spread after draining the field for 1 acre.
Banana	Sigatoka disease	Due to the pre monsoon showers, there is chance of Sigatoka disease in banana. As a precaution, Spray Pseudomonas 20g/L In case of severe attack spray 1 g Bavistin by mixing it with gum in 1 litre of water on lower surface of leaf.
Vegetables	Aphids	Apply tobacco decoction or 2% neem oil-garlic-soap emulsion for control of aphids in cowpea.
