



Crop	Stage of the crop / Pest/Disease	Advisories	
Paddy (Jyothi, kanjana, Uma, Ponmani)	Seedling stage	There is a chance of rice case worm in paddy field. To control this 25 kg sawdust mixed with 1 litre kerosene can be spread after draining the field for 1 acre. Fields which cannot be drained can be sprayed with fame (2ml/10L) or Coragen (3ml/10L).	
Coconut	-	Soil can be made to a good tilth in coconut farms to enable the rain water infiltration and proper soil air movement. Measures should be taken to control weeds and root grub.	
Banana	Sigatoka	There is a chance of sigatoka in banana field. Apply Tilt 1 ml/1 litre of water.	
Vegetables	Stuted growth	There is a chance of stunted growth in bitter gourd. As a preventive measure spray cows urine 50 ml/ 1 L water.
