Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of moderate rainfall in isolated places of the district. Above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Prophylactic measures can be taken to control and to avoid the spread of crop pest and diseases. Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

Crop	Pest/ Disease	Crop/ Animal Advisory
Rice (Mundakan) Tillering stage	Bacterial Leaf blight	To control and prevent bacterial leaf blight in paddy, dissolve 20 g of cow dung in one litre of water and spray the supernatant liquid by mixing with 20g of pseudomonas.
Vegetables (chilly)	Anthraco- nose disease	There is a chance of Anthracnose disease in chilly. As a prophylactic measure, apply 1% Bordeaux mixture or spray pseudomonas 20 gm per liter.
Turmeric	Leaf Blotch	Due to high relative humidity, there is a chance of leaf blotch diseases in turmeric. As a prophylactic measure, spray 2ml hexaconazole or 1 ml Propiconazole or 2 gram SAAF or 2.5 g copper oxychloride or 2 g copper hydroxide dissolved in one litre of water. Otherwise 1% Bordeaux mixture can be sprayed. Spraying can be continued at fortnightly intervals depending upon the intensity of the disease. Uproot and destroy fully infected plants.

Animal Husbandry: Vaccinate animals against foot and mouth disease and hemorrhagic septicemia. If needed give medicine against worm infestation after dung examination. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
