1. **INTRODUCTION**

Located in the southernmost tip of India, endowed with the rich diversity in flora and fauna of the Western Ghats, beatified with affable climate ranging from tropical to subtropical, Kerala is in fact a 'God's Own Paradise' owing to unimaginable beauty bestowed on the State by horticultural abundance. Horticulture is the main stay of agrarian economy of Kerala occupying almost 90 per cent of the cultivated crops in the state. The tropical humid climate is ideal for cultivation of wide array of horticultural crops like fruits, vegetables, plantation crops, spices, medicinal plants and floriculture crops. Kerala's spices and condiments have attracted European traders even as early as 15th century onwards and has been the main source of foreign exchange for the State. Kerala accounts for 95% of nutmeg, 76 % of cardamom, 67 % of rubber, 33 % of black pepper, 27 % of coconut, production in India. The State contributed to the export of processed horticulture products worth Rs.2251.82 Crores (2023-24) signifying the role of the food processing industry ('sun-rise' sector) as an off-shoot of this vast science of Horticulture.

Today the University's precincts are dotted with hundreds of agro-nurseries catering to the planting material requirements of the entire state. Skilled horticultural professionals have plenty of opportunities in plant propagation units, commodity boards, plantation management, floriculture and landscaping, processing and export sectors besides the state department of Agriculture, Vegetable and Fruit Promotion Council of Keralam, Commodity Boards, Agriculture Scientists Recruitment Board, and other allied organizations.

The four-year BSc (Hons.) degree programme has been conceptualized based on the recommendations of the 'Sixth Deans Committee Report-2024'. The course has been formulated for all-round academic excellence and skill development of the graduates by providing them core competence in all areas of horticulture. In view of the requirement of skilled professionals in the horticulture based industries, commodity boards, state agricultural department, plantation sector, processing and export units in the state and outside, the BSc. Horticulture programme assumes relevance. It has been formulated for skill enhancement of the graduates making them competent and confident for emerging needs of the state.

The course curriculum encompasses core courses, skill enhancement courses, elective courses and ability enhancement courses. The course is intended to equip students with production technology and management in plantation, spices, fruit science, vegetable crops, floriculture & landscaping, medicinal & aromatic crops and post-harvest technology. The programme will also cover the basic knowledge on crop production such as agronomy, soil science, plant pathology, entomology, genetics & plant breeding, social sciences and basic sciences etc., that are important in designing the future horti-preneurs. The BSc (Hons.) Horticulture course aims to provide high-quality education, combining theoretical knowledge with practical experiences, ensuring that graduates are well-prepared for future challenges in the dynamic field of Horticulture.
