- 1. Proof of Date of Birth High school/ Class X/ Matriculation Certificate.
- 2. All Certificates and Mark sheets/ Grade reports, related to Class X and Class XII/Plus Two onwards.
- 3. KEAM 2024 CANDIDATES DATA SHEET and /or CUET (ICAR-UG) 2024 Rank Card downloaded from the concerned KEAM/ CUET websites as the case may be.
- 4. Original Transfer Certificate (to be submitted within 3 working days, only after confirming admission)
- 5. Character / Conduct certificate (original) from the Head of the Institution last studied.
- 6. Migration certificate (original)
- 7. Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCLC) in case of reservation candidates under SEBC (Ezhavas, Muslims, OBH, LC/AI, Dheevara, Viswakarma, Other Backward Christians etc.). Non-Keralite and CUET (ICAR-UG) applicants are not eligible for communal reservation.
- **8.** Community Certificate (for SC/ST candidates). Non-Keralite and CUET (ICAR-UG) applicants are not eligible for communal reservation.
- 9. Medical certificate issued by the competent authority in the case of Differently Abled (PwD) candidates.
- 10. Income and Asset Certificate (for Economically Weaker Section candidates) (original).

- 11. Physical Fitness Certificate issued by Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.
- 12. Nativity Certificate
- 13. Aadhaar Card
- Candidates are directed to keep sufficient photocopies of each certificate mentioned above with them at the time of admission.
- Admission fee as specified in the Prospectus of the related course is to be remitted by all the candidates at the time of admission. Admission fee is <u>Non Refundable</u>. (Fee is collected by UPI/QR code)
- The Semester fee, Caution Deposit as specified in the Prospectus of the related course has to be remitted at the allotted institution at the time of registration of semester.
- Candidates who fail to report in person for admission along with the documents as specified above or fail to remit the admission fee at the time of admission will lose their chance for admission without assigning any reason or any further notice. In such cases, next eligible candidates from the list will be given admission according to the rank and the reservation. No further claim in this regard will be entertained.

Note: This admission is under RF mode and hence, fee concession is not available to the candidates enjoying communal reservation.
